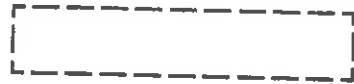


Butterfly or Moth?

3. A butterfly rests with its wings up.

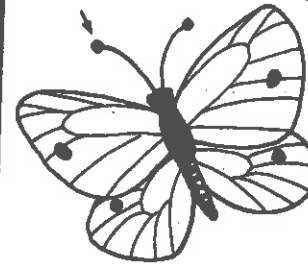
4. A moth rests with its wings spread out.

6. A moth comes from a cocoon.



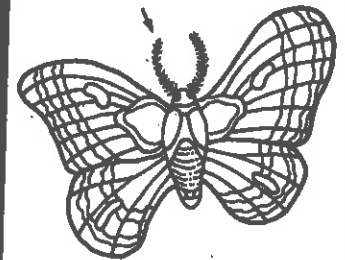

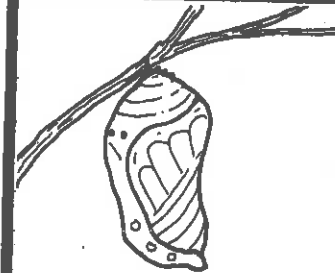

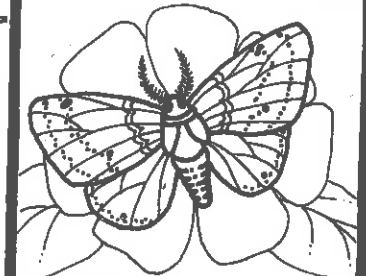
