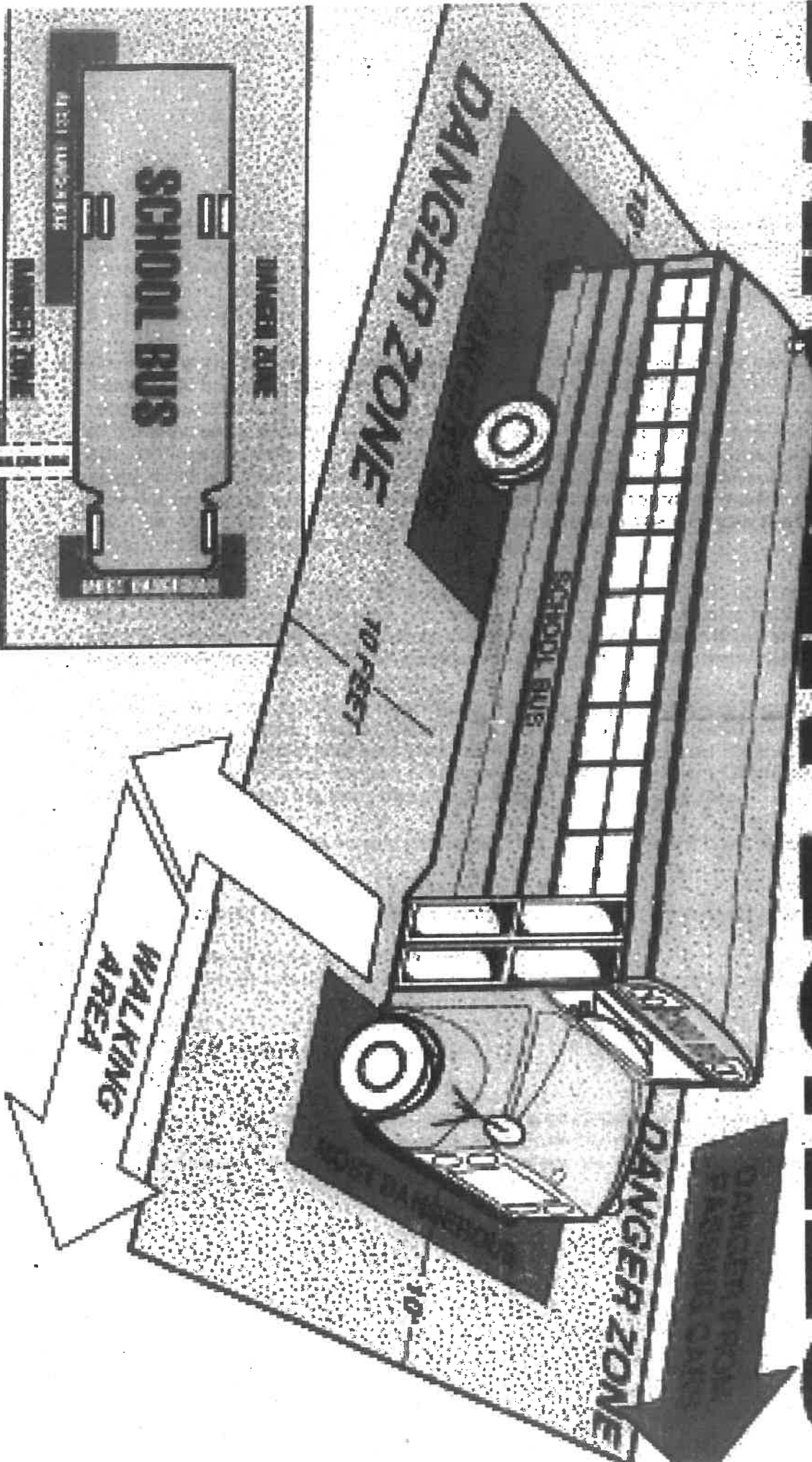

EXPECTATIONS FOR BUS STUDENTS

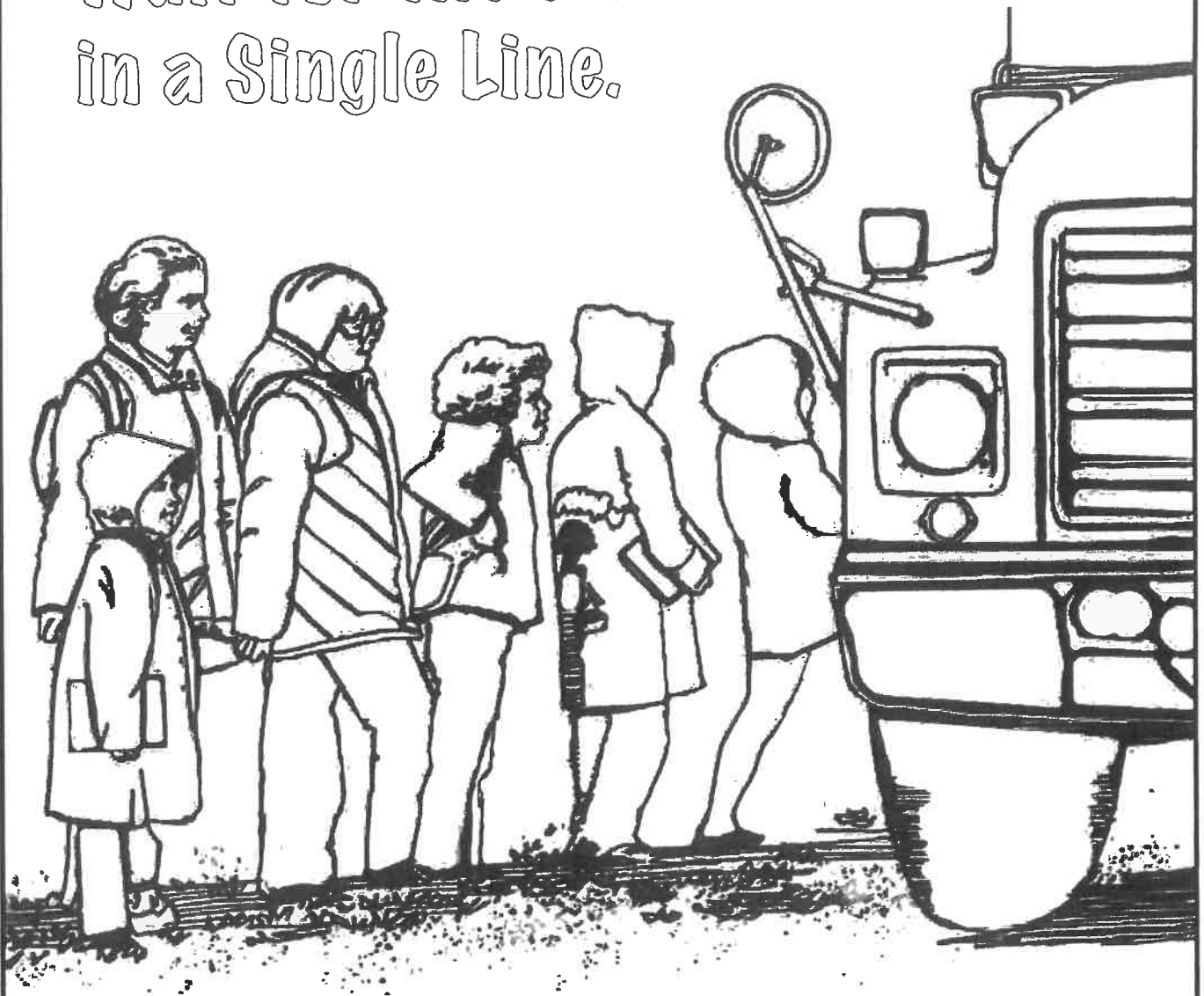
ALL STUDENTS ARE EXPECTED TO:

Follow directions promptly and courteously

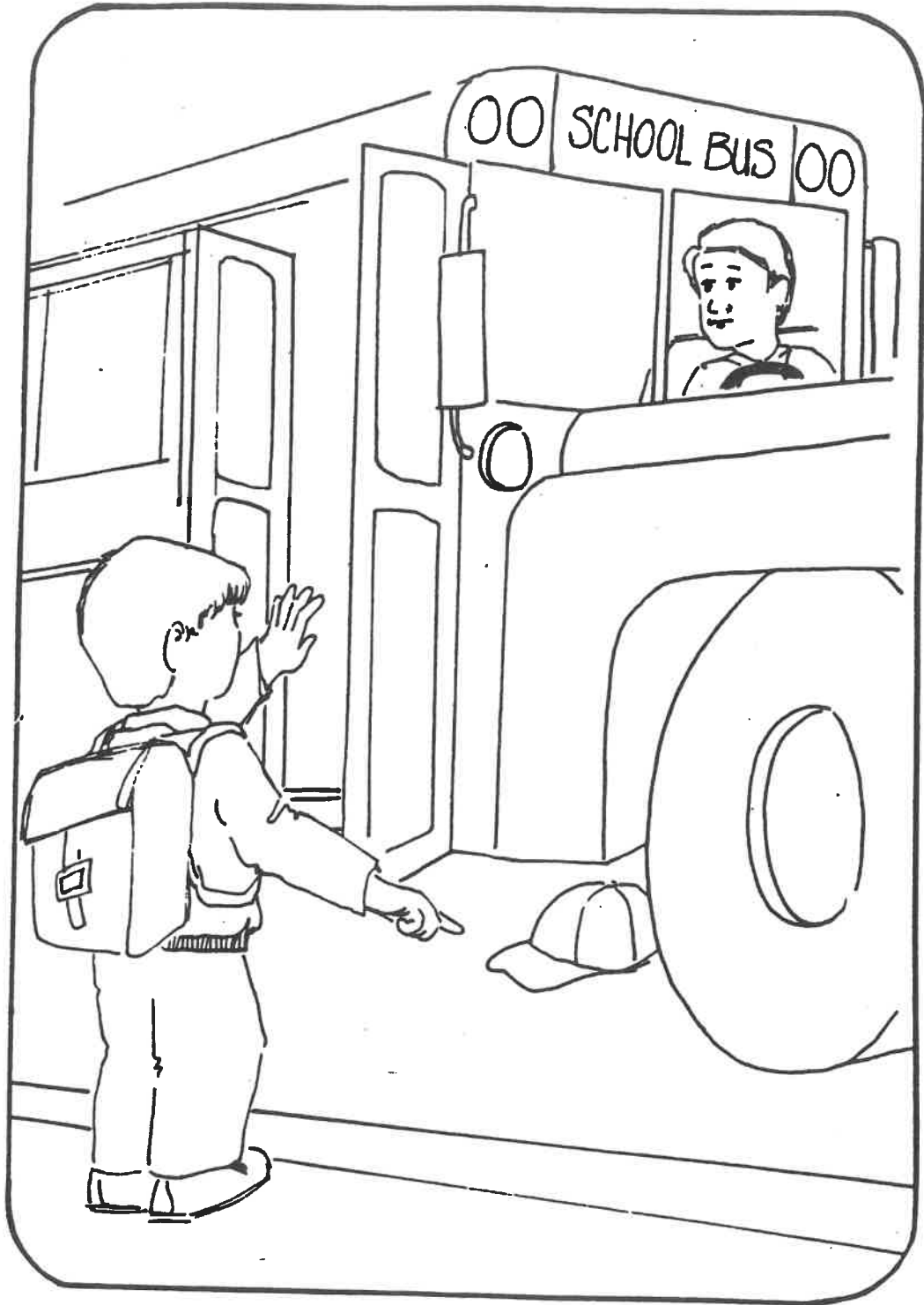

Wait for the Bus in a Single Line.



-  Always wait for the bus in a single line.
-  When getting on the bus, stay away from the danger zone, make eye contact with the bus driver, and wait for the driver's signal. Board the bus one at a time.
-  Don't push or shove to get on or off the bus.



If you drop something near the bus, leave it!

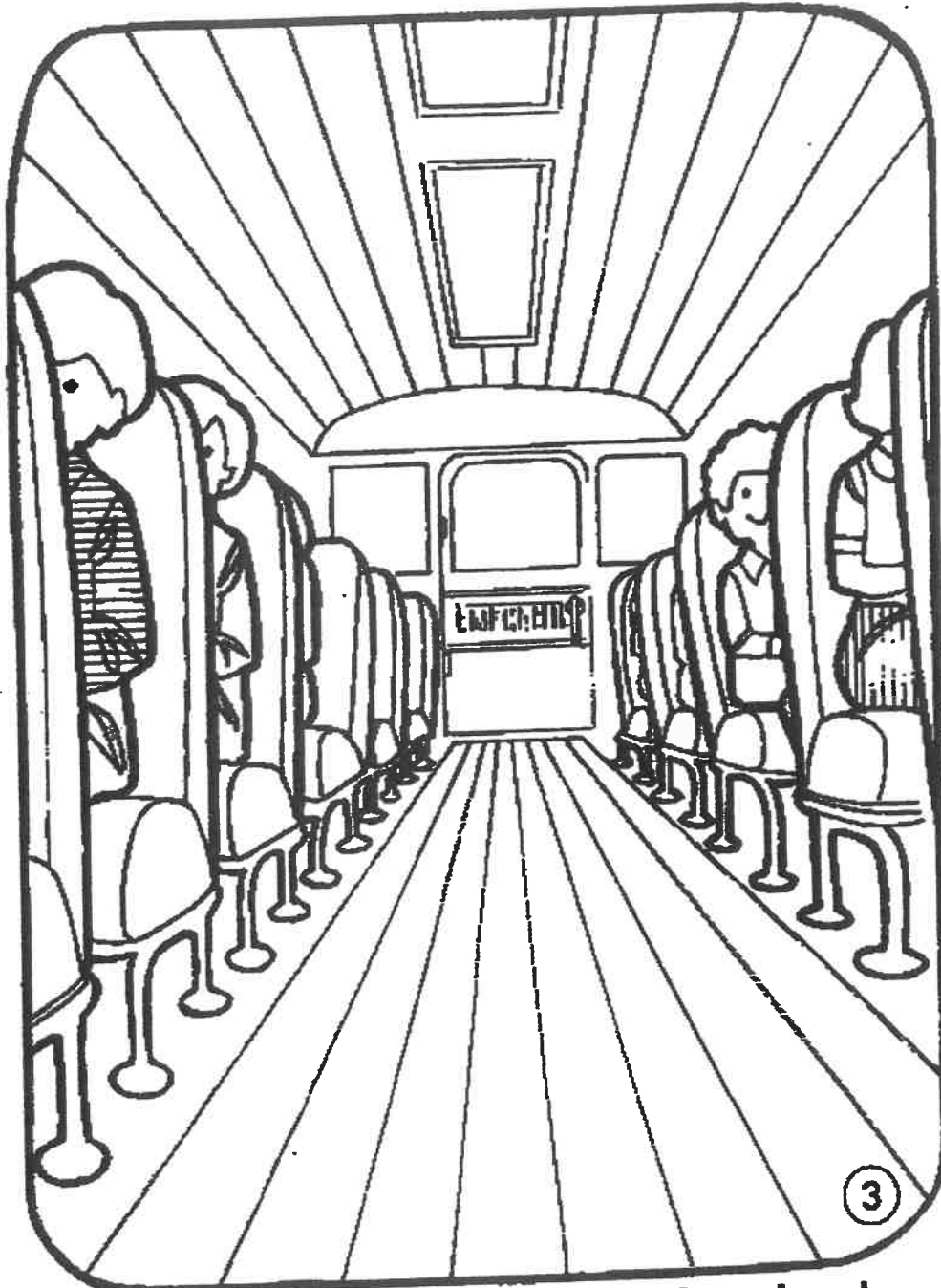
Tell the bus driver.

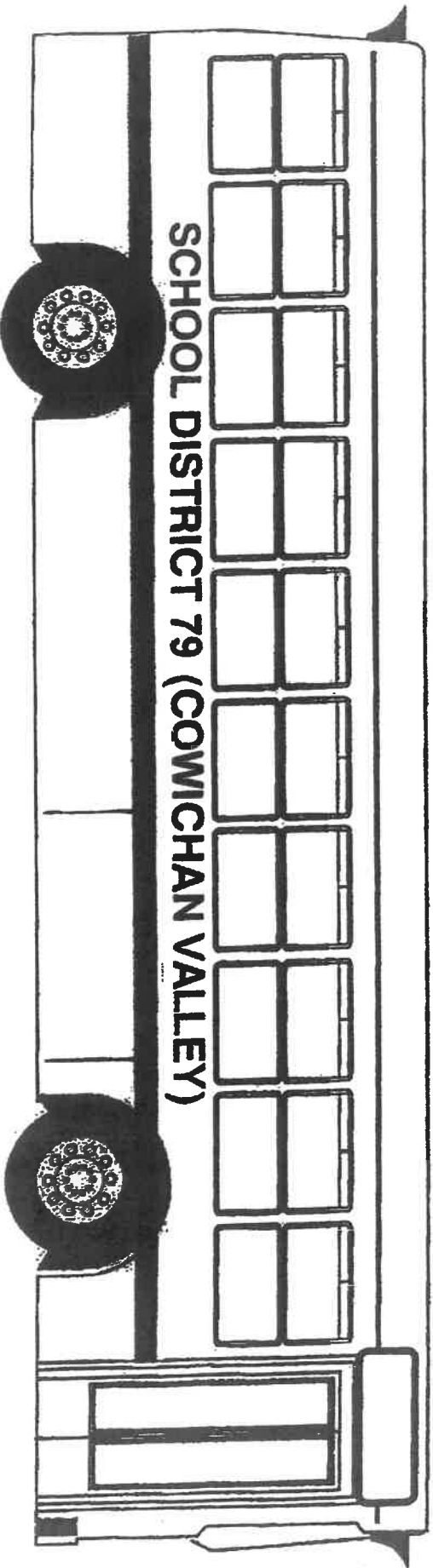
